My name is Mawazo, a 16 year old girl who was first enslaved from the first fFirst fleet, a week ago. I was enslaved for one reason only because of my skin colour and my ethnicity; I am Abriginal, of course, the whites here don't seem to like us; fiFirst they stole our land and now they are raping and impregnateing the females; I am afraid I'm next, going I tryto try to keep my head up every single day; The whites have just know started to kill us for not contributing on things to things they say for us to do; I just saw aUncle Jimmy's friend Bobby' get killed with a the with the spear we used to hunt with for the kangaroos; Bobby allegedly got killed because he refused to sweep and clean the dog poo. Uncle Jimmy was destroyed because he and Bobby grew up together, went through thick and thin too, me on the other hand hurt in the heart because I saw them two become adults together and of course raising me too, † I definitely felt Uncle Jimmy's pain.

This all officially started exactly on the 20th of January so.. 6 days ago; My tribe and I were just playing a game of hide and seek and the elders cooking elders were cooking as we are doing were doing all that minding our business as Aunty y Kuata noticed 11 ships coming our way, w; We were all suspicious and concerned on my so the males get got their spears and weapons to go the go to the shore of the beach to start the attack they attacked because attack because never in their life have they seen big ships coming on our land to come invade to invade us. The 11 ships were coming closer and closer. My people thought it was going to take a turn but it didn't. The whites finally ended up coming and my people attacked but the guns scared them off and my people gave up ...
